Teacher / House Master

All teachers are Officers of the Academy and wear a uniform with appropriate rank.

- provide proof of relevant teaching experience. While membership in the Ontario College of Teachers or an equivalent teaching degree is an asset, it is not mandatory for applying to this position;
- be willing to work unconventional hours including weekends, and participate in extra-curricular activities before, during and after school;
- work as a positive influence within a team environment;
- communicate effectively with colleagues and students;
- have excellent oral and writing communication and presentation skills;
- be capable of fulfilling the physical requirements of the position;
- provide a satisfactory police certificate with vulnerable sector screening.
